David Osser is Associate Professor of Psychiatry, Harvard Medical School at the Brockton Division of the Veterans Affairs Boston Healthcare System. There, he is the attending psychiatrist for the Domiciliary Residential Treatment Program for Homeless Veterans, and a consulting psychiatrist in the VA National Bipolar Telemental Health program. He has published about 100 academic products with.mobi), original articles, reviews, courses, decision-support software, and abstracts.

Osser is on the editorial boards of the *Journal of Clinical Psychopharmacology, International Drug Therapy Newsletter* (renamed *Psychopharm Review*), *Psychiatric Times, CogentMedicine.com* (a website where articles are reviewed: he edits the schizophrenia section), and the *Model Curriculum for Psychopharmacology* of the American Society of Clinical Psychopharmacology (7th ed., 2012).
