Dr. Baker is Director of the Neurochemical Research Unit at the University of Alberta. He is a former Chair of the Department of Psychiatry at that university, a past president of the Canadian College of Neuropsychopharmacology and a former Tier I Canada Research Chair. Dr. Baker is currently a Fellow of the Canadian Academy of Health Sciences and a University of Alberta Distinguished University Professor. He was Series Co-Editor for the book series *Neuromethods* and has served on the editorial boards of several journals. He has published over 300 peer-reviewed papers, and his main research interests are mechanisms of action and metabolism of psychiatric drugs, etiology of psychiatric and neurologic disorders and drug development, with a focus on neuroprotection.
